Framing is important, particularly in the jurying process and we hold our members to a high standard. Just to review—all paintings competing in the Artist of the Month or exhibited in the Business Exhibits should be framed in a professional manner with wire hangers and D-hooks. If an oil painting is painted on a gallery wrap canvas and the edges are painted, that is acceptable.

CKAG members only may exhibit in the Artist of the Month contests. Only one painting is allowed for competition. A second painting can be brought for viewing only. As was voted in the March meeting, former Artist of the Year winners will no longer be included in the competition but can bring a painting for viewing. We will no longer have a Professional Category in the Artist of the Month contests.

Minutes of Meeting—Elizabeth Parks

Following the customary 2-month sabbatical, CKAG welcomed 14 members and one new member, Gwen Yarbrough, to the March 2014, meeting. President, Debbye Hassell, introduced representatives of the Grayson County Alliance, Rita Stevenson and Sarah Thorpe, who relayed information about the annual Art in the Park Juried Fine Arts and Crafts Show scheduled for May 17-18 at Leitchfield. They shared some of the requirements for entry and encouraged attendance. For the entry application and additional information, go to the website, gcartinthepark@gmail.com, or phone 270-589-1425.

A balance of \$3,212.68 was reported by the Treasurer with only one disbursement for newsletter preparation. Carl McKinley reported a membership of 37 members, but suggested an updated Membership List be made and circulated. Carl is also resigning as Membership Chair because of medical reasons. Juanita McCoy will take over as Membership Chair. Business Exhibits were arranged for March-June. Mary Lou Hall mentioned that framed prints were acceptable for sale at the Business Exhibits as well as original art. Jo Friel reminded members of the “Paint-Along” still life workshop to be given by Theresa Shelton on May 24. Reservation forms are/will be included in the March and upcoming newsletters. The cost is \$25 and is to be mailed with the reservation form by May 17 to Jo Friel, 123 Westwind Trail, Bardstown, Ky 40004. A supply list will be sent via e-mail or snail mail along with the location of the workshop. A discussion was held about the possibility of lowering the cost of workshops for non-members to encourage participation. Debbye Hassell reported that the artist/materials representative from Maine, Ed Brickler, was available to teach a workshop in the near future, but it was decided not to schedule him at this time. Joyce Lupresto reported that Marilyn Matthews would present the April program, “Color Schemes/Limited Palette”. Joyce also indicated the desire to organize plein air dates for CKAG during summer months.

Mary Lou announced that the Rotary Club ticketed auction is to be held April 18 at the Brown-Pusey House with a generous guarantee of 50% above purchase price, should the reserve price be met and exceeded. The contact person for this event is James Jeffries at Hardin County Water District #2. Mary Lou also reported that Suite 500 (Our Place) has been rented and is no longer available to the Guild as of the March meeting. The former meeting place at Nolin RECC may be available on a temporary basis, but at a different day of the week since the 3rd Monday slot has been taken. Mary Lou indicated a possible future meeting site may be the lower level of Suite 500, also owned by Dr. Hall. After a tour of this area, those present decided to wait until renovations are complete before making a decision. Members voted that the Nolin site be used until a later date.

It was decided that the Professional Category be eliminated from the AofM competition and that those members not compete in the General Category for at least 3 years.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned. Following refreshments, a very informative program was given by Jo Friel on achieving subtle blacks in watercolor backgrounds by using a combination of colors. Submitted by Elizabeth Parks

Theresa Shelton, a long-time award-winning member of Central Kentucky Art Guild, will teach a special oil painting workshop at Our Place at 790 North Dixie Suite 500, Elizabethtown, Kentucky, on Saturday, May 24, 2014, from 10 a.m.-3:30 p.m. Details are below on the Reservation Form, which will need to be mailed with a check to the Workshop Chairman, Jo Friel, by May 17. Space is limited—so reserve early.

Theresa is a very talented artist who paints still lifes and landscapes. She has agreed to teach a class using one of her still life paintings as a guide. A photo of one of her beautiful still life paintings is shown below.

Anyone who has ever wanted to learn oil painting or who is already an experienced painter will enjoy the workshop. Theresa will use the paint-along-with-me technique to demonstrate how she obtains the composition, depth of color, and color harmony in her paintings.

This will be the third workshop in a series, which CKAG is sponsoring using well known, talented, and award-winning artists from the central Kentucky area. If you would like to become acquainted with art and artists in this area, these workshops are a good way of doing so. CKAG is a multi-media group featuring artists who work in oils, watercolor, graphite, pastels, and other media. Periodic workshops offer an opportunity to see how they work and discover new media in which one might be interested.
