MINUTES OF OCTOBER MEETING

Mary Lou Hall called the meeting to order at 6:21 p.m. on October 16, 2017. There were no visitors.

Joyce Lupresto reminded members to sign up for the Mixed Media Workshop to be given by Paula Haynes on October 28 from 10 a.m.-1 p.m. The workshop cost is \$40.

Several changes were made to the **Constitution and Bylaws**:

Article III-Membership-Section 3: The last sentence, “Patron members shall not vote, hold office, or have exhibition privileges” was deleted.

Article IV-Annual Dues-Section 1: Annual membership dues shall be \$30. Dues are not pro-rated at any time.

BYLAWS Article I-Officers’ Duties-Section 1: The Vice President shall:

d. Chair the All Member Show and shall select at least two other persons to serve on the committee.

Article III-Committees-Section 1.2a: Program Committee—responsible for all programs for monthly meetings.

j. Gallery Director Committee deleted. Workshop Committee was added. This committee will be responsible for finding leaders, scheduling workshops, enrolling and collecting entry fees from workshop participants, and supervising the workshop. Cost of workshop should be borne solely by participants.

Article III-Meetings-Section 3: Regular membership meetings shall meet the third Monday of each month. In January and February, meetings shall be held on the 2nd Saturday at 10 a.m., weather permitting.

Mary Lou asked for a volunteer for Program Chair, and Paula Haynes graciously offered. Karen Hart was also nice enough to volunteer to take over Publicity responsibilities from Mary Lou.

Website: Theresa reported that she was a little behind in putting the newsletters on the site because she is in the process of selling her home and moving.

December: The Guild voted to keep the December meeting on Monday the 18th. It will be a potluck and spouses are welcome.

Artist of the Year:

A. Jo Friel’s Artist of the Year show will be in January or February of 2018.

B. Tom Hammett’s Artist of the Year show will be in October of 2018.

C. Joyce Lupresto suggested that the artist chosen as Artist of the Year exhibit some of their works in the ECTC Library. This exhibit would be ongoing through the year and would require approximately 8 pieces of artwork.
