

Supply list for Workshops with Valerie Allen
Collage and Encaustic Effects with Acrylic

Plastic table covering that will cover your painting space.

Pencil (*I use an Ebony Design pencil for planning*)

Scissors (*use economy grade as we will be cutting materials that can dull the scissors*)

Palette knives and/or painting knives to apply thick gels and grounds

Brushes: 1" nylon and some smaller detail brushes -I use flats in various sizes from 1" down and filberts in size 10 and 4. Bring brushes that are for acrylic. No natural hair—synthetics are great. I also use 1" cheap foam brushes and hardware nylon brushes used for house painting.

10 foam plates-lunch size

Freezer paper

Sketch book or paper for class notes

Spray Bottle

Paper Towels

Water Container-medium size

Apron or paint shirt

A paper bag that can be set up as a trash container at your work station.

Golden Artists Colors will supply specific colors of acrylic paints, gels and pastes for this workshop. I will be supplying two 8" square boards for the two collages.

Little things that may come in handy—Bottled water or a pop to drink, tissue, scotch tape, sweater.

***Your paintings will be "Wet" when you head home at the end of day. Please consider how you will transport them home. Some ideas: Put a trash bag down in your trunk to lay the paintings. Pizza boxes make great transport containers! Plastic table cloths.
