Minutes of Meeting—July 20, 2015

Due to the AC unit not working at Our Place, members of CKAG met on July 20, 2015, at Halls Rentals Suite 800, 790 North Dixie in Elizabethtown .

President, Debbye Hassell, opened the meeting at 6:30 p.m. She was complimented on the biographical piece that appeared in the newsletter. A spontaneous suggestion was made that all present might briefly share information about artistic interest.

Committee reports were then presented: Treasury, Membership, Business Exhibits (current displays will be changed on September 21), Workshops, and Website (Theresa Shelton encourages members to send updated images of art).

Mural: Mary Lou Hall explained that the product being applied to seal the downtown mural is usable in heat up to 90 degrees. Given the high temperatures this summer, it will be necessary to wait until the weather cools.

All Member Show: Promotion of the exhibit was discussed. Debbie Beyerlein will contact local newspapers and radio stations, while Debbye Hassell will create a flyer. Ms. Hassell will also send e-mails reminding members who have signed up for various tasks or to bring refreshments to the reception.

New Officers: A committee to nominate officers was formed. Mary Lou Hall, Joyce Lupresto, and Karen Hart intend to have a list of candidates by the August meeting.

Website: Theresa Shelton added further information about the CKAG website: for members who send in images of work, she will create a page, which will include biographical info, more images of work, and a link to the artist's website.

Programs: Joyce Lupresto asked if there was interest in inviting a photographer—with education experience—to present at a future meeting. The topic would be photographing art for entering shows. Many expressed an interest.

Mary Lou Hall had planned to present a demonstration on painting in watercolor on Yupo. With the meeting being held in a much smaller space, the program was postponed. We can look forward to this lesson at the August 17 meeting. Members are asked to bring one tube of cheap watercolor paint and a flat brush. Mary Lou will provide the polypropylene (Yupo).

After the break, the AofM entries were viewed. The voting resulted in some surprises—there was no third place winner. There were ties for both first and second place. Results are listed in the Artist of the Month table elsewhere in the newsletter.

Since the program was not given, the meeting adjourned early.
