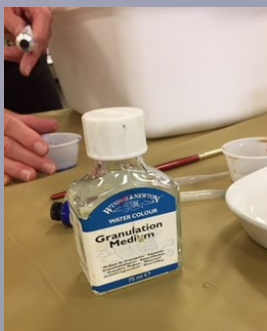
**July 16, 2018**, at 6:30 p.m. at Our Place, 790 North Dixie Suite 900, Elizabethtown, Kentucky.

### **MEMBERSHIP:**

We will need at least 40 paintings to hang at the venue.

**SCHEDULE:** August 10: Entries due

Monday, August 20 Deliver paintings to gallery 1-4 p.m. Paintings also can be given to Jo Friel at the meeting.

Friday, August 24 Opening Reception 5-7 p.m. Presentation of 1st, 2nd and 3rd place awards.

September 17 CKAG Meeting. Rebecca Wilkinson will do the program. We will have a reception in her honor. The winner of the Peoples' Choice Award will be announced. Also Mrs. Wilkinson will present the Founders' Award. This award will be voted by artists who submitted works to the AMS.

Friday, September 21 Show ends.

The juror will be Luci Mistratov, Ph.D.

Mary Lou will look into the cost of having live music at the reception. Former members are allowed to participate. Artwork can be older than three years since entrants will be allowed to choose what they consider to be their best work.

### Artist of the Year: Tom Hammett

Tom's Artist of the Year reception will be held at the Morrison Gallery on Friday, October 12 from 5-7 p.m. His works will be on display from October 9-31. NOTE: These dates have changed since they were originally posted in the newsletters.

**FYI:** Joe Cecil's show will be opening at the Morrison Gallery on November 9. The reception will be that day from 4-6 p.m. The show is called "Viking Gods Evoked".
