

## THERESA SHELTON OIL PAINTING WORKSHOP—Saturday, September 15 at Our Place

#### Cost \$30

Doors will open at 9 a.m. Be set up and ready to start by 10 a.m. Bring your lunch or Wendy's is next door. Clean up 3:30-4:00 p.m.

<u>Paint:</u> Bring your favorite oils if you have some. At least bring Titanium White, Cad Yellow Light, Cad Yellow Med or Indian Yellow, Cad Red Light or Orange, Permanent Rose or Alizarin Crimson, Ultramarine Blue and Cobalt or Thalo Blue.

<u>Oil Paint Medium:</u> I use walnut oil. **DO NOT** bring mineral spirits or turpentine. I will bring Gamsol for everyone to use so there is minimal smell.

<u>Brushes:</u> Bring at least 1 small to medium flat bristle brush, 2 flat synthetic brushes that come to a good edge, small and medium. I like Robert Simmons Titanium Flats, size 2, 4 & 6. One small script brush to sign your name. Spend money on good brushes. Cheap brushes will only make you mad when painting.

One stretched canvas or panel in a small size, 8x10, 9x12, 11x14 but no larger than a 12x16. If you feel industrious, bring two! Bring a table or floor easel, paint palette, a box to transport your painting home, and a palette knife.

Wear paint clothes! Bring VIVA paper towels, floor cloth or newspaper to use under your easel, small pliers to open paint tubes, small trash bag (grocery bag will work), cardboard box to transport wet painting flat.
