The meeting was called to order by President Tom Hammett at 6:42 p.m. with 11 members present including a new member, Jo Anderson. We had one guest, Lois Himes.

A motion to approve the minutes was made by Paula Decker Haynes and seconded by Joyce Lupresto. Motion approved. Correction to newsletter: Tom Hammett's work will be on display at the Larue County Public Library throughout the month of May—not June.

Tom challenged the membership to consider presenting to the Guild something that is valued as an important detail in one's art, i.e. "What makes a watercolor painting good?", something that will help the membership grow and improve as artists.

**All Member Show:** August 23-September 20. Drop off art-August 21. Reception-August 23 from 5-7 p.m.

Joyce Lupresto reported that the judge for the AMS will be Judy Mudd for a fee of \$125. Joyce presented a proposal for the membership to consider: prior to the AMS, Judy will teach a class on watercolor for \$75 per person per day, 1-3 days if desired. Discussion followed that CKAG would charge \$100 per person, meaning \$75 to the artist and \$25 to CKAG. Joyce stated that Judy was an accomplished artist in all mediums and would be able to give guidance to all participants. Discussion followed among members that the "judge" working with the membership prior to the show might influence the judging of the show. It was felt that the class should be after the show. Another suggestion was to poll the membership by e-mail for a response regarding the class. Joyce will work with the artist and will report later to the Guild.

Tom reported that he had found a nonprofit website: [callforentry.com](http://callforentry.com), a clearing house for people looking for artists for different projects, whereby, one may apply for an art project. For more information, contact Tom.

Mary Lou Hall announced she recently visited Brandenburg and found they have commissioned an artist to paint the history of the town on huge panels. While speaking with the artist, she invited him to present a program to our CKAG. She left her business card with him, but he has not responded.

**Program:** Anna Miserendino gave the program on painting Ukrainian Easter eggs.
