Minutes of Meeting-August 19, 2019

The meeting was called to order by President Tom Hammett with 16 people present including visitor Darlene Fred.

Approval of Minutes: The Minutes were accepted as correct after discussion.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Treasury: Our balance is \$2,062.48.

All Member Show and Judy Mudd Workshop: It was reported that we had 13 people who had signed up to attend the workshop. As of this writing, we have 23 entries for the All Member Show. Members expressed they would like to have a punch bowl for the reception, and Joyce agreed to bring hers.

Publicity: Tom mentioned he still had not been able to speak with anyone regarding the billboard near I-65. Karen Hart states that she submits information to various papers; however, they seem to choose what they want to print. She mentioned a group on Facebook called Hardin Local, but she is not “tech savvy” enough to figure out how to include CKAG on that. Kim Mann mentioned she might be able to help with that.

Programs: Upcoming programs were mentioned. Paula stated that they would be printed in the newsletter once they are decided. Theresa mentioned that she had not had time to do anything with the website.

Artist of the Month: The following themes were mentioned as having been received for the upcoming year: Angular, Celebration, Old Fashioned or Vintage, Highlight & Shadow in 2 Colors, Abstract, Mixed Media, Prints from Printmaking, Paint an 8x10 in 100 Brushstrokes, Drawing in Pen/Pencil, Perspective, Charcoal.

Christmas in the Park Art Contest: Kim Mann said they are wanting CKAG to provide them with 2-3 judges. They also asked if we would provide a prize or an art set for the winner of each grade K-5. Discussion was that CKAG should select the prizes appropriate for each grade level. A \$10 prize was mentioned. Kim will do the shopping at Hobby Lobby or Preston Arts. This will be discussed further at the next meeting.

Debbie Hassell reported she had recently visited Preston Arts Center. They told her they would help promote CKAG if we would be willing to advertise for them. She agreed and brought a bundle of flyers from Preston.

It was reported that Paula had won 4th and another ribbon at the State Fair. Charlotte Brammer, Wes Kendall and Gwen Yarbrough had received a ribbon of some sort.
