

#### Minutes of Meeting-September 16, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m. by President, Tom Hammett.

**Approval of Minutes:** Phyllis Blakeman moved to approve the Minutes as read, Wes Kendall seconded, and motion approved.

**Treasury:** The Treasury has a balance of \$1,912.82 as indicated in the September newsletter.

**Discussion of Business Exhibits:** Mary Lou Hall announced that CKAG has a new location for displaying art at the Home of Philanthropy (Central Kentucky Community Foundation) located near the public library. The space will accommodate one artist upstairs in a conference room and four paintings downstairs.

Joyce Lupresto stated that the ECTC library is under construction for soundproofing the walls; therefore, CKAG may not be able to exhibit on that wall space. However, a fewer number of paintings is a possibility. Joyce will report next month regarding this.

**Old Business: Christmas in the Park**—Members, Joyce Lupresto, Mary Lou Hall, and Kim Mann volunteered to be the judges of the entries. CKAG will give six 1st place prizes. Clark Jewelers can make plaques for the winners with our CKAG logo for \$10 each.

All Member Show: Members should pick up artwork on Monday, September 23 between 12 noon-4 p.m.

**Lincoln Days Art Show:** Phyllis Blakeman invited the membership to enter works of art September 25, 2019. Entry fee is \$10. Categories are Open, Photography, Lincoln-Related and Larue County.

Tom extended an invitation to a video viewing entitled, "Why Beauty Matters" in Room 133 at the James S. Owen Building of ECTC, at 3 p.m. on September 24.

**New Business:** The Artist of the Year Exhibition of Paula Decker Haynes will be November 8-December 1, 2019, at the Morrison Gallery. The reception will be on November 8 from 5-7 p.m.

**Saturday Workshops:** A life model is needed for the workshop on October 19. Mary Lou suggested that a committee be established for management of the Saturday workshops. Gwen Yarbrough, Joyce and Mary Lou volunteered as members. Paula made a motion that a Saturday workshop committee be established with Gwen, Joyce and Mary Lou as members. Mary Lou seconded the motion and motion carried.

Gwen Yarbrough reported that the theme for the Artist of the Month is: October-Open and November-Human Perspective. In December, Tom stated that he would make a display board of suggested themes for 2020. Only members of CKAG may vote on six of the displayed themes. The six themes with the most votes will be announced at the Christmas dinner.

Phyllis Blakeman made a motion that our meetings start with the program presenter and have the business meeting following that. Paula seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Artist of the Month: Only one entry was brought. Charlotte Humphress received 3 points.

The meeting was called to order at 6:43 p.m.

Phyllis Blakeman moved that Kim Mann be responsible for selection of prizes, and Gwen Yarbrough seconded. Motion approved. The selection of judges was not voted on at this time.
