#### MINUTES OF MEETING

In the absence of our President, Debbye Hassell, Mary Lou Hall called the meeting to order at 7:27 p.m. on January 20, 2020. There were 14 people present, including Linda Miller and Deb Mulligan. The Treasurer's report was given.

<u>Exhibits:</u> Joyce Lupresto stated she had called and left a message with the librarian at ECTC regarding exhibit space. She will get information about hanging space that may be available. Janet Gebler recommended she go during off hours since classes have just resumed and parking is full.

<u>Programs:</u> It was mentioned that Tom Hammett had been trying to get the person who has the Amoru exhibit at ECTC to do a program. Paula Haynes also stated she was trying to get Deb Mulligan to present a program on pottery making. Mary Lou asked Dr. Bauer if he might be interested in doing a program on his woodworking, to which he agreed. Dr. Bauer mentioned that he and about four other volunteers met at Bernheim recently for a social. One friend was a jeweler from Bardstown who is very knowledgeable about geology.

<u>Workshops:</u> Anna Miserendino will be having her free egg painting workshop on March 7 starting about 9 a.m. The workshop will either be at her home (with 3-4 participants) or at Our Place if more people attend. She will get a headcount on persons interested at the next meeting and will report information for the newsletter. Joyce brought up the Saturday drawing workshops. She feels it is a good idea to bring still life setups and suggests bringing something that would make the painting more personal to the viewer. Mary Lou has another light, which she will bring. We do have a model for February. Janet thanked Paula for posting on Facebook.

<u>Artist of the Year:</u> Charlotte Humphress talked to Rachel Ray at ECTC. She is wanting to move the All Member Show to the first part of the year. Therefore, Charlotte's show will be in January 2021. Charlotte also mentioned she went to The Cecilian Bank for take down her AofM painting, but the bank was closed. She will not be able to return until Wednesday for removal.

Mary Lou stated that Tom had e-mailed her regarding the art contest of the E'town Women's Club. The Club would like for CKAG to judge the contest. The paintings will be brought to Our Place sometime between February 24-March 5. This is apparently just for students in Elizabethtown. Kim Mann is trying to determine if home schoolers are allowed to participate. Mary Lou made a motion that CKAG judge the show. Motion was approved.

The Artist of the Month themes were discussed. Phyllis Blakeman stated that she has some of her artwork hanging at the Larue County Public Library this month. If anyone has any art-related items they wish to get rid of, bring them to Our Place. Mary Lou has some books but could not carry them. Voting for Artist of the Month took place. Meeting dismissed about 8 p.m.
