February Program—Dr. George Bauer

Dr. Bauer came prepared with several of his wood turned items in various stages of completion for CKAG members to view as he discussed the art of woodturning. He discussed how he became interested in the hobby about 1991. While taking a carving course, he met a Danish family doing wood turning. Upon returning to Elizabethtown, he was talking with Dr. Knight who invited him to his home and for two weeks "instructed" Dr. Bauer how the process worked. Dr. Bauer discussed the various woods, how to safely mount the wood to the lathe, and other instruments for working the wood. Dr. & Mrs. Bauer had a drawing for a door prize, and Paula Haynes was the winner of the hand turned ornament.

MINUTES OF MEETING

President Debbye Hassell called the meeting to order at 7:29 p.m. on March 17, 2020. There were 17 people present, including four visitors.

TREASURER and MEMBERSHIP: Treasury report was given. We currently have 38 members with 15 unpaid members. It was mentioned that members would be dropped at the end of March if dues are not paid.

BUSINESS EXHIBITS: Mary Lou Hall mentioned she will not be present next month and wanted to get the Business Exhibits lined up for the next quarter before she leaves. She asked about the exhibit space at the Extension office. Tom agreed to go by and check that out.

WORKSHOPS: Joyce Lupresto reported she still had not gotten a response from the librarian at ECTC regarding available space at the library. She did find out that the hanging rods had been damaged and ECTC did not have funding to replace them. She will call in 3-4 months and inquire as to when they appropriate money. In the meantime, she will pick up the CKAG plaque for safekeeping.

Anna Miserendino is planning for her egg painting workshop on March 7 at Our Place from 9 a.m. to noon. She suggests that participants bring an egg carton and an old towel. Seven members expressed interest in attending. If you do wish to attend, give her at least a day's notice so she can get together the material needed.

OLD BUSINESS: Tom Hammett mentioned that the January Minutes needed some clarification in respect to the All Member and Artist of the Year shows. He will discuss with Rachel Ray at ECTC. He also stated that we need judges for the high school art contest sponsored by the E'town Women's Club. The club will deliver the artwork to Our Place on March 2, judging will take place on March 4 at 1:30 p.m., and pickup on March 5. Gwen Yarbrough, Tom, and Joyce agreed to judge the show.

NEW BUSINESS: Paula Cohn asked if anyone might be interested in doing a collage challenge. Idea would be to meet about 30 minutes prior to the CKAG meeting to discuss their work. If anyone is interested in doing this, plan to come next month with finished piece.

Joyce mentioned that although the Bylaws were unclear, members should be present if they are submitting artwork for entry into the Artist of the Month contest. She understood that someone might be sending in a piece just to assure we have five pieces for voting. However, by doing so, it could possibly take points from another member. Motion was made that member must be present to submit an AofM painting. Motion passed.

Discussion was held regarding several possible road trips. Kentucky Crafted Market will be held in Lexington on March 14. Those interested should plan to meet at Our Place about 8:30. Show will be from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Preston Arts will have their Materials & Methods Expo in June. If you are on their mailing list, Debbye thinks you receive 10% off in addition to the discount they offer that day. Several people expressed interest in doing this.
