## Minutes Of Meeting

Central Kentucky Art Guild met on May 17, 2021, at Our Place. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by President, Debbye Hassell. There were 13 present, including one artist visitor, Cody Ray.

Debbye asked members if the previous Minutes of Meeting were accepted as submitted and the membership agreed.

Debbye announced that the Treasury reported a balance of \$2,555.87 at the end of April with \$30 dues being received and an expense of \$50 for the newsletter. The membership report was announced that we currently have 26 members, including 2 patron and 2 honorary members.

Business Exhibits were discussed. It was decided that Paula Decker Haynes will move her artwork to the Hardin County Public Library. Mary Lou Hall will try to find someone to exhibit at the Dermatology office. Gwen Yarbrough mentioned that she has her artwork hung at the library in Hodgenville. The Business Exhibits will now be back on their quarterly schedule. Mary Lou also reminded members that the Artist of the Month has a reserved space to hang their winning piece at The Cecilian Bank.

Workshops: On June 26 from 10-2 p.m. at Our Place, CKAG will have a workshop on the Skinny on Design—Elements & Principles and how to use those to design a painting. A Tony Couch video will be shown in addition to sketching and discussion sessions. The fee is \$10, open to CKAG members and non-members. Bring a soft and hard pencil, sketch pad, a drink and sack lunch. A sign up sheet was passed around for those interested in attending.

Programs: Ideas for upcoming programs were discussed. Paula Haynes suggested bringing anything you have worked on during Covid. It was decided to do a 30-day challenge until next month. If you can post on Facebook, do so or send to Paula and she will post for you. Bring in your sketchbook next month to share with members. Paula Cohn presented the idea to bring in the art envelopes, a previous challenge, for all members to see. In July Joyce Lupresto will teach a program on plein air painting. In September Paula Cohn and Marilyn Matthews will have a program on mono printing or gel printing.

Debbye brought up the idea of using the time allotted at the Morrison Gallery for our All Member Show (Aug 23-Sept 17) be split between the AMS and the two Artist of the Year shows (Charlotte Humphress and Gwen Yarbrough). Gwen indicated she was not opposed to this idea or even that a week would be enough for her. Debbye will contact Charlotte and get her thoughts. Debbye would prefer to use the first 2 weeks for the Artist of the Year shows giving her more time to find a judge and prepare for the All Member Show the last 2 weeks.

Debbye would also like to restart the Drawing Classes on Saturday before the meetings. These classes will be at Our Place unless an alternate location, such as plein air, is decided.

Voting for Artist of the Month entries was discussed. There seems to be some confusion as to the wording of the Constitution & Bylaws in allowing entries to be “sent” rather than brought to the meeting. A motion was made to continue to have AofM voting online for the months of May and June because of Covid precautions. Beginning in July, artwork shall be brought to the meetings. It is encouraged that members be present; however, the artist can send their artwork with another member if circumstances arise that prevent them being able to attend. Kim Mann made the motion. Paula Haynes. Motion passed with one “No” vote.

Debbye brought up the question of “do we want to remain a small art group or do we want to expand with technology”? She said we could do a mix of online and in person. She said it limits our group to do everything in person. Paula Haynes suggested we research other art groups and see if they have online material. Some felt we ought to stay a small group as some members are not technology minded. Paula Cohn mentioned that she is a member of several different art groups on Facebook. She feels we are a group that wants to grow by sharing our skills. It was suggested that we use Facebook more and explore the possibility of doing YouTube videos in 2-3 months.
