Minutes Of Meeting

The CKAG meeting was called to order at 6:34 p.m. on June 21, 2021, by President Debbye Hassell. Ten persons were present, with three visitors, Cody Ray, Marlene Youngblood and Vicki Thomas. It was decided since there were not enough members present to constitute a forum, we would not discuss business related issues until next month.

Several members brought their art journals they had created over the lockdown and their 30-day challenge which started last month. Paula Decker Haynes stated she only spent about 10-15 minutes on each of her sketches. She felt she has learned so much since she started sketching last year. She had already done a 100-day challenge in addition to the CKAG 30-day challenge. She also brought some of her "junk journals".

Gwen Yarbrough mentioned that she mainly does watercolor but has been experimenting with charcoal and pencil. She not only did her sketchbook but started doing bookmarks, cards, and miniature paintings.

Cody Ray, our visiting artist, stated because of his vision he doesn't sketch but he sees "blobs" of color and paints those to make his artwork. He also stated that he paints a lot of art for people, recalling one he did of the helicopter two military men lost their lives in in Vietnam and one of a local young girl who had lost her life a few years ago. He reported that he ran out of canvas and started painting on poster board.

Mary Lou Hall mentioned that she had been just about ready to give up art during the lockdown, but this 30-day challenge renewed her interest causing her to jump in and do something. She has enjoyed this challenge and hopes that we will continue to do them. She recommended using a spiral notebook for purposes of photographing and/or to paint.

Marilyn Matthews stated she uses her journal to be free and to develop. She plans to use it as an inspiration for future paintings. She took online classes with Danny Gregory in Sketchbook Skool.

Paula Cohn brought some of her gelli printing samples. Said she practiced abstract shapes in various colors. She has always liked painting.

Debbye Hassell brought her travel journals from her trips to Australia and China. She had done her sketches in pencil and ink with the idea to fill in later with watercolor. She pointed out that she used the back page of her journal to test out her colors on the paper.

After members had enjoyed browsing all the art journals, Debbye gave us the dates for the All Member Show and Artist of the Year shows.

The Artist of the Year combined show (Charlotte Humphress and Gwen Yarbrough) will be August 23-September 17. Reception will be August 27.

The All Member Show will run from September 27-October 22. Reception will be October 1. The deadline for entries will be September 13 and art needs to be delivered on September 24. Kim Mann is working on finding a judge.

The wording of the Bylaws was brought up regarding the Artist of the Month entries being "sent" to the meeting if one is unable to attend. It was also recommended that we limit the number of times to 3 per year for any artist. This will be discussed at the next meeting.
