MINUTES OF MEETING

Central Kentucky Art Guild met on August 16, 2021, at Our Place. Eleven members were present. No visitors. The meeting was called to order at 6:32 p.m. by Debbye Hassell. The Treasurer's report was read, and the Membership reported 29 active members, including two patron and two honorable.

Business Exhibits: Mary Lou Hall reminded members that there is a special place for the Artist of the Month to hang their winning artwork at The Cecilian Bank. The current exhibits will hang until the meeting date in December.

Workshops/Programs: Marilyn Matthews and Paula Cohn are scheduled to do the program in September on mono print and gel printing. Debbye asked if anyone had any ideas for the October program. Mary Lou suggested we could practice painting with leaves. She will put together a project list for October and plan this.

Old Business: Artist of the Year Shows: Gwen Yarbrough and Charlotte Humphress stated the artwork for the shows had been delivered and hung. A sign up sheet for refreshments was passed around to members.

Mary Lou thanked members for coming in on Saturday to clean the meeting place. She also explained that the items sitting along the wall were found during the cleaning spree. Members discussed meeting on September 11 at 9:30 a.m. at the Pritchard Community Center garden area and at Bernheim Forest on October 9. There is also a plein air session scheduled at Knob Hill September 18 from 1-4 p.m.

Jury Committee: Joyce Lupresto asked members how many were interested in being juried. Kim Mann and Terri Friel (via Jo) would be interested, so a jury committee will plan to meet at 10 a.m. on October 20.
