
This will be a "hands on" fun project.

VIGNETTE

When Mary Lou and I presented the "Skinny on Design" by Tony Couch, the word, "vignette", came up. We were looking for definitions. I just came across this one in "Ink Line Sketching" by Paul Lascaux:

VIGNETTE—This type of drawing concentrates the rendering of tones and detail around the center of the drawing or focal points within the view; degree of rendering diminishes with proximity to the edge of the drawing. This convention imitates our visual ability to focus on one object in a cluttered scene while disregarding the surrounding context. It is a form of selection with which we can direct attention or create emphasis.
