A FABULOUS FREE LEARNING OPPORTUNITY FOR OIL AND ACRYLIC PAINTERS

I had followed a wonderful college painting teacher (oil and acrylic) from the Univ of SC and tried to attend her workshops.

About 4 years ago, Mary Gilkerson went totally online and was very successful. Recently she had thousands of people from all over the world. The 10 self-paced lessons on such topics as Values or Color were multi-videos. This was not a cheap class—about \$1000 for the entire class. As long as Mary taught, you had access to her classes. She also did coaching through weekly hour-long sessions to which you could submit your work and get live feedback. Best painting teacher I have ever had! Not only could she PAINT but unlike some she could also TEACH!

Long story short—about 2 months ago, Mary announced that she had recently been diagnosed with Stage 4 breast cancer. We were unaware that cancer was a problem. And 3 weeks later, her daughter announced that she had died in her sleep.

The daughter decided that in memory of her mom to put her lessons on **YouTube** where you can access them free. I am not sure if the weekly coaching sessions will be available or not. What a memorial and gift to us all! Here is the link:

MEETING MINUTES: May 16, 2022

Vice President Joyce Lupresto called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.. There were 15 members and 1 guest (Teresa) present. Tina Perkins joined the Guild as a new member. Welcome to our guest and new member!

- I. **TREASURY:** The ending balance in April was \$2,272.46. Expenditures for April were \$50 for the newsletter and \$40 for the fee to exhibit at West Point. A new junior member added \$15 to the Treasury.
- II. **MEMBERSHIP:** There are currently 31 members, 5 being junior members and 24 regular with 2 honorary members.
- III. **WEBSITE:** No report.
- IV. **BUSINESS EXHIBITS:** On June 20 the Business Exhibits change out. Kim Mann volunteered to hang at the Hardin County Library and Gwen Yarbrough will hang at the Home of Philanthropy. The Cecilian Bank and Associates in Dermatology need artists. The Artist of the Month continues to hang at The Cecilian Bank.
- V. **PROGRAMS/WORKSHOPS:** Prior to the meeting, Dyann Joyce gave a presentation on how to use multi-media on Masonite boards to give an oil paint look to a painting. She provided tips on layering mediums effectively. In June Debbye Hassell and Paula Haynes will show the group how to make a Pochade box.

Joyce Lupresto presented a "Pattern to Pastels" workshop on May 14. Joyce donated \$40 back to the Guild. On June 11 (second Saturday) the group will meet at the Pritchard Community Center in Elizabethtown to create plein air paintings in the garden areas. Folks are meeting at 10 a.m.

VI. **OLD BUSINESS:** The West Point exhibit is scheduled for June 18. Anna Miserendino and Gwen Yarbrough volunteered to help Paula Haynes set up the booth on Friday, June 17 at 1 pm at the Veterans Park in West Point.
