MEETING MINUTES: June 20, 2022

President, Mary Lou Hall, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. There were 14 members present with no visitors.

- I. TREASURY: The balance at the end of May 31, 2022, was \$2307.46.
- II. MEMBERSHIP: We have had four new members to join.
- III. WEBSITE: No report.
- IV: BUSINESS EXHIBITS: The Business Exhibits are set to change on June 20. Kim Mann volunteered to hang at the Hardin County Library; Gwen Yarbrough will hang at the Home of Philanthropy; Dyann Joyce volunteered to provide pieces for hanging in the Association of Dermatology office. The Cecilian Bank needs artwork. The Artist of the Month winning piece continues to be at The Cecilian Bank. (Correction: Dyann Joyce at The Cecilian Bank and Karen Callahan at Dermatology).
- V. PROGRAMS/WORKSHOPS: Prior to the meeting, Paula Decker Haynes and Debbye Hassell gave a presentation of pochade boxes. Jo Friel agreed to provide a "black background" presentation for watercolor paintings for the July program.
 - WORKSHOPS: On July 9 the group will meet at Our Place for still life drawing. (This has been cancelled because of lack of interest). On August 1 from 9-12 noon, Paula Decker Haynes will instruct In "making your own art journal" from a magazine. Cost is \$25 each. Then, on October 15 from 9-3 p.m., Larry Elmore will provide an oil painting workshop at a cost of \$100 per participant.
- VI. OLD BUSINESS: CKAG cancelled participation in the West Point Festival due to lack of interest. Start painting now for the West Point Festival 2023!
- VII: NEW BUSINESS: The CKAG All Member Show is scheduled for August-October with a tentative September 2 reception. A planning committee is needed and volunteers to check the art pieces in and out. Dyann Joyce volunteered to serve on the committee. (Changes have been made with dates. See Calendar on Page 6).

The Aspiring Young Artists High School Art Exhibit committee (Paula Decker Haynes, Dyann Joyce, and Kim Mann) reported to the group that December 20 would be the deadline for entries. January 14 (Saturday) would be the date students are to deliver their artwork to Our Place and January 21 (Saturday) will be the reception from 10-12 p.m. A picture will be on the flyer to demonstrate how to properly wire the back of the artwork. Pieces without frames/wires will not be accepted. Size limitation will be 24"x36". Several members volunteered to take the flyers and information to individual high schools at the beginning of August when the entry form and flyer are completed by Juanita.

ANNOUNCEMENTS/REMINDERS: Gwen Yarbrough announced she will have a pencil/charcoal piece on display at the State Capitol Building.
