MEETING MINUTES: July 18, 2022

The July meeting was called to order at 6:28 p.m. There were no visitors although Dr. Hall came in shortly after the meeting started with Mary Lou. Thirteen members were present.

- I. TREASURY: The balance at the end of June 30, 2022, was \$2287.46.
- II. MEMBERSHIP: Currently there are 26 regular, 5 junior and 2 honorary members.
- III. WEBSITE: Theresa Shelton indicated that she was keeping the website current by uploading the newsletters. She has been searching Facebook for member photos to add to the website.
- IV: BUSINESS EXHIBITS: Business Exhibits were discussed. Paula Decker-Haynes agreed to hang on September 19 at The Cecilian Bank. Dyann Joyce took the Hardin County Library and Joyce Lupresto will display at the Associates in Dermatology office.
- V. PROGRAMS/WORKSHOPS: In August Mary Lou Hall will give the program on Planning Your Painting. Members need to bring gel pens or colored pencils. Dyann Joyce agreed to give a demonstration on UV resin epoxy art in September.
 WORKSHOPS: On August 13 from 9-12 noon, Paula Decker Haynes will instruct in "making your own art journal" from a magazine. Cost is \$25 each. She had a supply list and encouraged those interested to sign up on the form she had available. Then, on October 15 from 9-3 p.m. with a break for lunch, Larry Elmore will provide an oil painting/glazing workshop at a cost of

\$100 per participant. A sign up sheet for this was provided. A supply list is forthcoming.

VI. OLD BUSINESS: Brochures for The Aspiring High School Student Art Exhibit were passed out to those members assigned to various schools. Mary Lou will contact E'town HS, Paula Haynes will work on Grayson and Breckinridge counties, North Hardin HS is Kim Mann, Jo Friel will work with Nelson County, Dyann Joyce accepted John Hardin, Gwen Yarbrough has Central Hardin, Tina Perkins-Draper accepted Taylor, Marilyn Matthews is Meade County. Mary Lou suggested contacting Harriet Crain to see if she would go to Hart County. That leaves Larue and Green Counties with no representative. There will be no entry fee this year to students. Absolutely no sawtooth hangers will be accepted and paintings must be framed.

The All Member Show is scheduled and delivery of art will be on August 29 (Changed to Aug 24). Paula Haynes agreed to be present from 10-1 and Joyce Lupresto will be present that afternoon from 1-4:30. Tim Smith will judge the show on August 31 at 11. George Bauer has agreed to meet with him the day of judging. The reception will be from 5-7 on September 9. Artwork will be removed on October 3. Dyann Joyce volunteered to be present that day from 10-1. We still need someone for the afternoon. Entry forms will be prepared and will be due along with payment on August 22.

ANNOUNCEMENTS/REMINDERS: Theresa mentioned that she had brought some art books for members to take if they were interested.
