### MINUTES OF MEETING—October 17, 2022

The meeting started at 6:30 p.m. with the program given by Debbye Hassell on graphite/charcoal drawing techniques and tools.

President, Mary Lou Hall, opened up the business portion of the meeting after the program. There were 11 members and no visitors.

- I. TREASURY: The ending balance as of September 30, 2022, was \$2,121.89.
- II. MEMBERSHIP: No new members to report.
- III. WEBSITE: No report. Dyann Joyce recommended that Junior Members be added to the web site.
- IV. BUSINESS EXHIBITS: The Business Exhibits should change on December 19 as follows: Paula Decker-Haynes will move to the Associates of Dermatology. Dyann Joyce will hang in Hammer & VanZant Dentistry office, Karen Callahan will hang at the Hardin County Public Library, and George Bauer will take the Home of Philanthropy. Debbye will call Carl McKinley about hanging at The Cecilian Bank.

As a refresher for new members, Mary Lou reviewed the expectations of exhibit changing. The pieces are expected to be moved no later than December 19 with the hope that members can take down and move their pieces to the next exhibit the same day. The change of Business Exhibits coincides with the meeting dates (3rd Monday) so members driving a distance can move their pieces and attend the meeting while still in town. Mary Lou also reviewed the purpose of CKAG as stated in the Constitution.

V. PROGRAMS/WORKSHOPS: The oil workshop on October 15 by Larry Elmore reportedly went well. He taught the group oil painting techniques and how to get the oils to dry faster by using cobalt dryer. Paula Decker Haynes showed pictures of pieces completed during the workshop.

Programs: In November the group will go through Ian Roberts, "Five Steps to Good Design". The group decided to do the traditional Christmas get-together potluck and art exchange in December. During the meeting, members can create a small piece of art to give away at the gathering.

Mary Lou posed the question, "Is anyone interested in continuing the Second Saturday gatherings. Several members affirmed they were. November 12 we will have a live model. The group agreed the model will be paid \$40. Attendees will contribute to that payment. In December there will be no Second Saturday event. On January 14 Mary Lou volunteered to lead the group using watercolors. Everyone will bring their own supplies and special tools and the group will help each other as we art together.

Mary Lou requested ideas for Artist of the Month themes for 2023. The following were submitted by members: Fire & Ice, Watercolor Technique, Abstract Theme, Animal, Pen-Ink, 3 Different Mediums, and Light & Shadow.

VI. OLD BUSINESS: Aspiring Young Artists Exhibit: Paula Decker-Haynes reminded the point of contacts who reached out to area schools to contact them again before Thanksgiving to remind them of the first deadline (December 20 entry forms).

Mary Lou offered congratulations to Dyann Joyce for being selected "Peoples' Choice" at the All Member Show. Mary Lou also mentioned that CKAG absorbed a \$122.32 loss with the AMS and the ribbons cost \$107. Next year the goal is to find cheaper ribbon options.

Not mentioned in the meeting, but still Old Business—The Art Envelope exchange will start back in January. Members who are interested should sign up with Debbye Hassell, who volunteered to run the exchange again. The exchange was started during Covid to not only share art with each other via mail—but to share art with those who would see the mail. Originally the goal was to make an envelope with art on it or decorate a premade envelope and send to the person assigned to them. Over the Covid time period, members began encouraging one another by sending notes and art pieces inside the envelopes as well.

VII: NEW BUSINESS: Dyann suggested CKAG have an art booth/exhibit in the parking lot during a festival event in Elizabethtown. Mary Lou suggested we table the idea until new CKAG officers are on board and the Programs POC is putting together the 2023 events.


Kim Mann briefed the group on the Christmas in the Park poster contest. The committee chairperson, Ashley Brown, contacted Kim requesting art judges again from CKAG. She provided two dates for judging, November 7 or 8. Paula Decker Haynes, Dyann Joyce, and Karen Callahan volunteered to judge the contest on Monday, November 7. Kim agreed to get the time for them. The group agreed we should also provide the six winners medals for K-5 again. Kim will order/pick up the medals/deliver them to the Nolin POC.

Mary Lou announced nominations for Officers as follows: President-Paula Decker-Haynes, Vice President-Debbye Hassell, Secretary-Kim Mann, Treasurer/Membership/Newsletter-Juanita McCoy, Artist of the Month/Historian-Karen Hart (Mary Lou will assist), Publicity-Dyann Joyce, Business Exhibits-Paula Cohn, Programs/Workshops-Marilyn Matthews, Web site-Theresa Shelton. Members will have an opportunity to nominate other members to those positions and vote at the next meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 8 p.m. Mark your calendars for Second Saturday on November 12 and the next meeting on November 21 at 6:30 p.m.
