MINUTES OF MEETING—January 14, 2023

President, Paula Decker-Haynes, opened the meeting at 10:36 a.m. Fifteen members were in attendance (Paula Decker-Haynes, Debbye Hassell, George Bauer, Elizabeth Parks, Karen Callahan, Dyann Joyce, Tina Perkins-Draper, Juanita McCoy, Kim Mann, Elizabeth Mann, Marilyn Matthews, Jo Friel, Molly Jones and Josie Jones with one new visitor/member, Kara McGreal).

The Treasurer reported a balance of \$1,868.96 as of December 31, 2022. Total membership was 33 with 5 junior members. Paula reminded members to send in their dues by the end of the month in order to keep their membership. There was no website report.

BUSINESS EXHIBITS: Business Exhibits change on March 20, 2023. Paula requested that artists take pictures of their next exhibit to post on Facebook and the newspaper.

PROGRAMS/WORKSHOPS: Marilyn Matthews led a discussion about possible workshops and programs in 2023. She explained that programs are short presentations provided in conjunction with the monthly meetings and workshops are 2 or 3-hour weekend events. Marilyn presented the following ideas and members expressed interest:

- Acrylic medium presentation as a program.
- Pen and ink techniques as a workshop. Debbye Hassell volunteered to provide the workshop in July, a couple of months prior to the Artist of the Month pen and ink theme.
- Resin use and paper clay workshops. Dyann Joyce volunteered to lead these workshops or provide more information as a program.
- Digital art and graphite by Michael Fudge. Initial introduction may be as a program.
- Ways to make jewelry. POC: Dyann Joyce and Eric Eichenberger
- Leather working by Eric Eichenberger. There was interest in a program.
- Plein air techniques (how to start, how to focus, etc).

OLD BUSINESS: The CKAG Aspiring Young Artist Exhibit (AYAE) will be on Saturday, January 21 from 4-6 p.m. Awards will be presented at 5 p.m. Dyann volunteered to make the ribbons. Juanita needs the winners to print the programs to be used on Saturday. Judges are Abby Ray and Michael Fudge. Amy Smith from The News Enterprise and a representative from Elizabethtown Lifestyle magazine will also attend. Paula requested members attend the exhibit to show support.

NEW BUSINESS: Dyann raised the idea of separating the Artist of the Month into "Regular" and "Junior" categories and having a separate Junior category during the All Member Show. The junior members present agreed they would be interested. Paula asked members to think about this and gather more information (from youth) and any further considerations to bring to the next meeting.

Paula brought up the idea that the Aspiring Young Artist Exhibit should be moved to February and that would give the students/teachers more time to work on entries after the holiday break, prior to prom and graduation planning. The group voted to move the exhibit to February 2024.

The meeting adjourned at 11:15 a.m. The next meeting will be Saturday, February 11 at 10 a.m. Submitted by Kim Mann
