MINUTES OF MEETING—February 13, 2023

President, Paula Decker-Haynes, opened the meeting at 10:00 a.m. Eleven members were present and one guest (Raine Sessions).

The Treasurer's report shows a balance of \$2,153.96 as of January 31, 2023. Total membership was 25 regular with 3 junior members and 2 honorary. There was no website report.

BUSINESS EXHIBITS: Paula Cohn was not present; however, Marilyn Matthews has spoken with her. Marilyn said that Hammer & VanZant was no longer going to display CKAG artwork after March 20. The artist to hang at each exhibit location on March 20 will be determined at the next meeting. George Bauer expressed that the Home of Philanthropy was happy to have CKAG exhibiting in their building.

PROGRAMS/WORKSHOPS: Marilyn Matthews led a discussion about upcoming workshops and programs in 2023. The meeting programs will be as follows:

- March—Dyann Joyce presents leatherworking
- April—Joyce Lupresto presents plein air supplies and preparation
- July—Debbye Hassell presents ink

Workshops will be as follows:

- April 22--Paper clay (sculpting a fennec fox head) by Dyann Joyce, 10-2 pm, \$15 each, supplies will be provided
- May 13—Plein air painting with Joyce Lupresto from 10-2 pm at the Veterans Memorial at Freeman Lake in Elizabethtown (no cost, bring your own supplies).

OLD BUSINESS: In January Dyann raised the idea of separating the Artist of the Month into "Regular and Junior categories", and having a separate Junior category during the All Member Show. Several members offered pros (the Junior category may encourage junior members to participate and encourage other high schools to get involved. Marilyn offered junior members were capable and able to compete against regular members. After the discussion regarding a Junior member category, the group voted on Artist of the Month "Junior" category. Seven members voted yes, and four voted no.

Further discussion regarding the details of a Junior member category needed more thought and discussion in order to write it into the Constitution. One discussion point was if there were not at least three junior submissions, then the submissions could be auto judged with the Regular category. However, that would discount the junior member Artist of the Year point system. Paula suggested members think various details through regarding the new Junior Member category in order to codify the junior member Artist of the Month/Year at the March meeting, so we can put it into the Constitution.

The group also decided to form a Junior Member Activities Committee. Members on this committee would consider how to include Junior members in the All Member Show and develop the Junior member programs: Artist of the Month/Year and the annual Aspiring Young Artist Exhibit. The following members volunteered to be on the committee: Karen Callahan, Dyann Joyce, Paula Decker -Haynes, Kara McGreal and Tina Perkins-Draper.

The group discussed how the general membership would vote on the Constitution/Bylaws changes.

Marilyn proposed only members should vote for Artist of the Month. Some discussion occurred. Marilyn made the motion and Joyce seconded the motion. All were in favor. Only members can vote for Artist of the Month.

ARTIST of the MONTH: The theme this month was "Open". Several members participated including Joyce Lupresto, Paula Decker-Haynes, Marilyn Matthews, Kara McGreal, George Bauer, Kim Mann and Karen Callahan. Joyce's Yorkie took 1st place with 5 points, Kim's owl and Marilyn's abstract tied for 2nd with 3 points, and Karen's still life was 3rd with 1 point.

Reminder: In April our meetings will start back on the 3rd Monday at 6:30 p.m.. The March meeting is scheduled for Saturday, March 11 at 10 a.m.
