The program on “Plein Air set up” started at 6:30 p.m. Several members demonstrated and explained what they used for plein air painting.

CKAG President, Paula Decker-Haynes, opened the meeting at 7:30 p.m.

MEMBERSHIP: There were 15 members in attendance with one new member. Membership went from 27 in March to 29 members in April.

TREASURY: CKAG has a balance of \$2,174.34 as of March 31.

BUSINESS EXHIBITS: There was no report as Paula Cohn was not in attendance. Mary Lou offered the following feedback on The Home of Philanthropy. Recommends only medium-small size paintings. She hung larger paintings and the space was inadequate for the size.

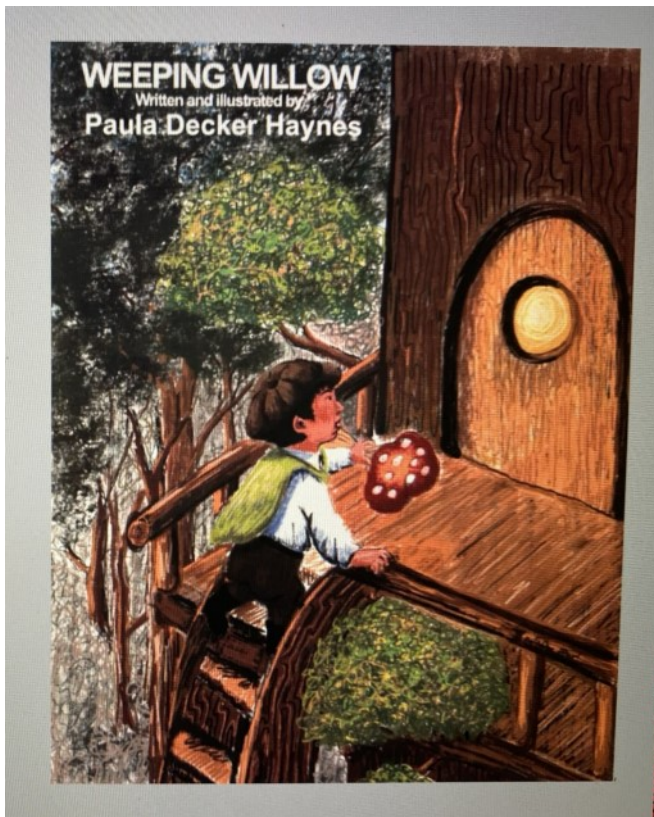
