BASIC WATERCOLOR TECHNIQUES FOR YUPO

July 15, 2023 from 10 a.m.-1:30 p.m.

Appropriate for beginning watercolor painters and watercolorists who simply want to try yupo. I will supply palettes and yupo paper.

Students must bring:

TUBES of paint (red, blue and yellow). Dried up paint and blocks of paint will not work.

Flat and round watercolor brushes

Box of tissues & roll of paper towels (Viva preferred)

1 or more 4” paint roller (buy at hardware store)

2 small water containers

Workshop will be limited to a maximum of 6 students at \$20 per student. Bring registration (name and phone #) with payment to the June meeting.

Bylaws Change: Due to the need to expel CKAG members for gross misrepresentation of the Guild and harassment of Guild members, Kim Mann made a motion to insert language into the Bylaws regarding expelling members. Exact verbiage will be voted on at the June meeting. Deborah Koch seconded the motion. All agreed on this motion. Debbye Hassell read Robert's Rules of Order for expelling any member of a club as a proposed addition to the Constitution after adjusting it to meet the needs of the Guild.

CKAG 30th Year Anniversary: The group discussed how to celebrate the Guild's anniversary. We settled on the idea of adding the celebration to the All Member Show. Deborah Koch volunteered to make cake. Debbye Hassell, as CKAG Vice President in charge of the All Member Show committee, agreed to absorb the celebration into planning the show. Debbye asked for volunteers to form the All Member Show committee. Anyone interested should contact Debbye.

Junior Member Committee & Meeting: The Junior Member Committee tentatively agreed to meet June 3 at 1 pm with Junior members Kim Mann agreed to provide an art program/activity with the Junior Members during the meeting. Deborah Koch expressed interest since her granddaughter is an artist.

PROGRAM: After the meeting, Paula Decker-Haynes provided information about the process she experienced making her children's book, "Weeping Willow". She also showed the group her homemade watercolor/art journals and a homemade watercolor lap book that is equipped with every tool to practice watercolor in the comfort of her recliner.

The meeting and program adjourned at 7:55 p.m. The next meeting will be June 19, 2023.

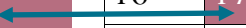
