Many of you know that I've been wanting the Guild to have "merch"—mugs, tumblers, but mainly a bag. I thought our anniversary would be a good time to pull the trigger on getting a bag. Please make your selections and contact me directly. We have two main decisions:

1. **The Logo:** Do we want to use our regular color wheel logo or the 30th anniversary logo?



2. **The Bag:** I've put together a couple of choices. Both of the choices are estimated assuming a 30-bag order; I wanted to keep the per-bag price at \$20 and below. Also, because of the nature of both logos, I focused on bags that could be screen printed as opposed to being embroidered. TREASURY: CKAG has a balance of \$1,940.03 as of June 30 2023.

BUSINESS EXHIBITS: The Business Exhibits were changed in June. The next change will be September 23. The following members are hanging in the exhibit locations: Hardin County Library (Paula Decker-Haynes), The Cecilian Bank (Mary Lou Hall), Associates in Dermatology (George Bauer), and Home of Philanthropy (Theresa Shelton).

All Member Show: The All Member Show committee needs to present information for the show. Debbye Hassell said she would confirm the gallery is reserved with Rachel Ray. From our May notes, (members had discussed how to celebrate the CKAG 30th anniversary. It was decided to incorporate the celebration with the All Member Show. Deborah Koch volunteered to make the cake. Debbye Hassell, as President in charge of the All Member Show committee agreed to ab-
