MEMBER NEWS

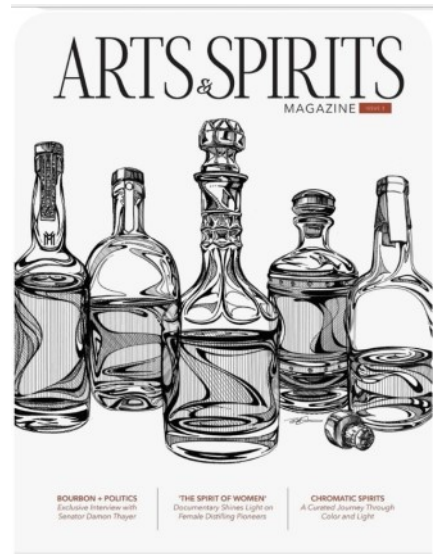
Dear Members:
