MINUTES OF MEETING—February 10, 2024

CKAG President, Paula Haynes, opened the meeting at 11 a.m. Prior to the meeting, Tina Perkins-Draper led a program in pan (soft) pastels.

MEMBERSHIP/ATTENDANCE: Twelve members attended with three guests: Gaylene Lacefield (she is interested in becoming a member. Her medium is glass), Michelle Rocha (high school student), and Jacob Jenkins (high school student). Twenty one members have renewed their membership to date. All members should have their dues paid by the end of February.

TREASURY: The current CKAG balance is \$2,048.56. Income received: \$360 membership dues and expenses was \$50 for the newsletter.

WEBSITE: Nothing was reported.

BUSINESS EXHIBITS: No report was given.

The group discussed “alcohol ink” as a possible workshop and agreed October would be a better time to open the doors and have a fan to release ink fumes.

PUBLICITY: Malinda Sieg reported the Instagram page, centralkyartguild, is now active. We encourage members with Instagram accounts to find and follow the page. Also please go through posts to like and comment on them. The more activity on each post, the better for the algorithm. Members should also send CKAG pictures, personal art, and interesting art information to Malinda for posting purposes. She is trying to post at least once a week.

Malinda reported that she will ensure the Aspiring High School Artists Exhibit information is in The News Enterprise. Pictures of the exhibit should be posted on social media and the website.

OLD BUSINESS:

Aspiring High School Artists Exhibit: Deadline for application was February 10. Registrations were counted and, to date, there are 27 students signed up. Saturday, February 17 from 10-12 pm at Our Place. Paula will be there to receive artwork. The following members will judge the art at 1 p.m. that day (Joyce Lupresto, Melinda Langley and Paula Haynes).

Saturday, February 14 from 4-6 is the reception. Malinda Sieg volunteered to make ribbons for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places with two honorary mentions. The cash awards of \$100, \$50 and \$25 will be given to the winners along with the ribbons. Paula considered providing unused art supplies she has to the honorary members. A request for members to sign up to bring food and beverages was sent out via e-mail, and the group talked about sending invitations to art teachers to share with students as a way to view local student art (even if they did not enter any pieces). Finally, Paula brought her display panels into Our Place in preparation for displays.

ARTIST OF THE YEAR: March 18, 2024, from 5-7 p.m. at the ECTC Morrison Gallery. Marilyn shared that Rachel Ray will send out an e-mail announcement and Marilyn is also printing invitations. At the next meeting, a sign up sheet will be sent around for food and beverages in preparation for Marilyn's show.

NEW BUSINESS: Members discussed the idea of hosting art shows throughout the year at Our Place. In the past, there was little interest in Elizabethtown. Paula and George mentioned that the Coca Cola company used to host annual art exhibits many years ago. The group talked about possible sponsorship with Elizabethtown businesses like Swope in order to promote a future art show at Our Place. The members will continue to discuss this idea.

ANNOUNCEMENTS: Morrison Gallery is currently featuring oil painter, Sandi Kimura, until February 23. The gallery is open Monday-Friday from 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Sandi created one painting per day in 2021 for one year during Covid. Approximately 22 pieces are on display and For Sale.

Preston Art Store (Louisville) is currently running a "Moving Sale". They are moving from Bardstown Road to Warwick Road and are running sales to decrease inventory for the move. They are currently running a 35% off sale.
