**Joyce Lupresto:** I had a painting accepted into the Kentucky Watercolor Society, Aqua Venture Show in Louisville at Kaviar Forge and Gallery. The painting is called "Waiting For Spring". The show begins March 17th.

**Marilyn Matthews:** In late January, Phillip & I had the opportunity to view a screening of the film *Loving Vincent* at the Speed Art Museum. It is the first of a kind, in that it is animated by some 65,000 oil paintings—Van Gogh style. Over 100 artists were employed to tell the story. For each second of the film, ten paintings were created. Often one will recognize an image taken from one of Van Gogh's own, as it morphs into another scene. It is such a moving portrayal of Van Gogh, I had to order the DVD. Hinting at the emotion that possessed the directors to undertake such a project, are these words by the reviewer by John Semley: "Directors Dorota Kobiela and Hugh Welchman's artistic ambition is matched by the laborious scope of their undertaking. In its ....very unfolding, *Loving Vincent* is a rapturously realized passion project that teeters, fittingly, somewhere between zealous enthusiasm and lunacy."
