Three visitors were present including Anita Friess, a friend and student of Phyllis Blakeman, Lois Cousins, a friend of Debra Beyerlein and assistant with the Zentangle program, and Carlene Priddy who visited last month.

Debbye Hassell recognized our visitors and then reported the Treasury balance of \$2,734 at the end of July. Membership dues are \$30 and are to be paid at the September meeting.

Mary Lou Hall agreed to continue to chair the Business Exhibit committee and accepted commitments for the next series of paintings to be hung. She stressed the importance of retrieving paintings in a timely manner in order for new paintings to be hung on September 15.

Jo Friel reminded the group about the Marilyn Matthew's upcoming "Flowers in Watercolor" workshop on September 6, 2014, at Our Place from 10 a.m. to 3:30-4 p.m. Cost of workshop is \$25.
