MINUTES OF MEETING—May 20, 2024

CKAG President, Paula Haynes, opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m. Prior to the meeting, Malinda Sieg demonstrated how to "Make Award Ribbons".

ART CRITIQUE: There was no art to critique. However, Paula wanted to insert into the monthly newsletter that anyone wishing to have a piece critiqued should arrive at 6 p.m. prior to the CKAG meetings.

MEMBERSHIP/ATTENDANCE: Eighteen members attended with no visitors.

TREASURY: The CKAG balance as of April 30, 2024, was \$2,028.22. Income was \$30 from membership dues and an expense of \$50 for the newsletter.

WEBSITE: Theresa Shelton reported that the newsletter is uploaded regularly on the website. She asked if the listing of members was still necessary on the website. The group agreed there were benefits to having members and their website links on the website. Theresa will update the membership on the website.

BUSINESS EXHIBITS: Business Exhibits will change on June 17. The following artists will have their work in the business locations from June 17-Sept 16.

The Cecilian Bank—Theresa Shelton

A rough estimate for the work is \$300. Cassandra will also test the panels to find out what kind of finish was originally used.
