MINUTES OF MEETING—April 15, 2024

CKAG President, Paula Haynes, opened the meeting at 7:16 p.m. Prior to the meeting, Carol Gammon demonstrated eggshell art embellishments.

MEMBERSHIP/ATTENDANCE: Sixteen members attended with Cassandra Carroll paying dues to become a member and guest, Michael Fudge, who planned to drop off his membership form and dues to Juanita later in the week.

TREASURY: As of March 31, 2024, the CKAG balance was \$2,048.22. Income received: \$127.05 from membership dues and Kroger rewards. Expenses were \$50 for the newsletter.
