## **MINUTES OF MEETING—January 18, 2024**

Program: The program for January was postponed and rescheduled for February to allow time to hear about the plans for the renovation of CKAG meeting space.

CKAG President, Paula Haynes, called the meeting to order at 10:01 a.m. Eleven people were present.

Treasurer's report: At the end of December, the balance was \$1,440.84.

Website: No report other than the high school QR code is working for printing the entry form.

Business Exhibits: Grayson County Library is a new location available for exhibit with space for about five pieces. Hours of operation are M-F 8 a.m.-6 p.m. and Saturday 8 a.m.-1 p.m. Paula has exhibited her pieces there until the next change.

Programs/Workshops: The February meeting will include a program with G.A. Wells on how to use a proportional divider.

Old Business: The high school show was discussed briefly as well as options should Our Place not be usable on the date. Later in the meeting, there was confirmation that the show, including acceptance of art, can continue with the construction going on.

A discussion about the books from the CKAG library included options for selling them on a website, having an in-house auction, and awarding participants a book for entering the High School Art exhibit.

New Business: The trip to KMAC for Aqueous, due to weather, was rescheduled for January 25. Members were asked to arrive at 9:30 for departure at 10. Also a cleanup day was set for January 23 to move CKAG items to the new storage area.

Artist of the Month: Two submissions for Artist of the Month, Marilyn Matthews and Paula Decker Haynes. The theme was "Good to Eat". The theme for February is Open and March is Animals.

Adjournment: At the conclusion of the meeting at 10:30, Kerry Hall Evans, the manager of Halls' Rentals, gave a presentation about the renovations and changes coming for the meeting space. Following the presentation, a walk through was offered to any members interested in seeing how the building layout will change.
