3rd place—Lily Anderson—“Sunrise Over the Green”

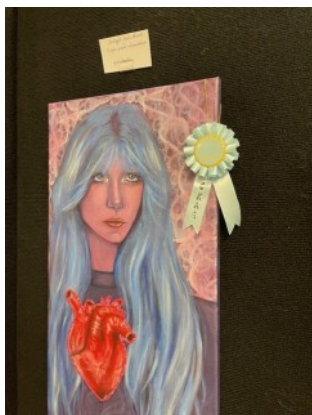
