## MINUTES OF MEETING— August 18, 2025

CKAG President, Paula Decker Haynes, called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m., following the presentation/discussion about gouache.

**Membership/Attendance:** Thirteen members were present . No change in membership.

**Treasurer's Report:** The balance at the end of July was \$1,239.31.

**Website:** Nothing to report at this time.

**Business Exhibits:** Exhibits will change in September. Carl McKinley will be at The Cecilian Bank, George Bauer at the Hardin County Public Library, Karen Hart at Associates in Dermatology, Paula Decker Haynes at the Grayson County Public Library. Home of Philanthropy will be announced.

**Programs/Workshops:** There are no workshops scheduled at this time. In September we will have a glass presentation by Rane Sessions. October will be basics of portraiture by G.A. Wells. November will be sketchbook sharing. December will be the Christmas gift exchange.

**Old Business:** The art-themed yard sale was discussed with the tentative time set for 10 a.m. to 12-noon on Saturday, September 27. Per the contractual agreement, CKAG will pay \$50 for the space. Members are encouraged to bring items for the sale to the next meeting so they can be stored to save time on the day of the sale.

A report concerning the possibility of meeting at the Hardin County Library included specific guidelines. A 5-person minimum and the space can only be reserved no more than 30 days in advance instead of ongoing from month to month.

2nd Saturday options were discussed. For September 13, it was agreed to meet at Storehouse Coffee House in Leitchfield.

The All Member Show report included the following details. Susan Christenson will be the juror for the show. Debbye will meet her there on September 5. Art will be accepted on September 2 by Mary Lou Hall and Theresa Shelton. Pickup of art will be on October 6 and will be covered by Rane Sessions and Theresa Shelton. Club members will bring refreshments for the opening reception.

**Artist of the Month:** We had a 3-way tie for 1st place: Rane Sessions, Michael Fudge, and Theresa Shelton. 2nd place: Paula Decker-Haynes. Then we had a 2-way tie for 3rd place: Karen Hart and George Bauer. Members were reminded to send pictures of their hanging art to Paula Decker Haynes, Juanita McCoy and Mary Lou Hall in order to get publication in the newsletter and newspaper. Also posting to the CKAG Facebook page was encouraged.

**New Business:** A brief discussion of the High School art exhibit ended with the decision to discontinue the event due to the prohibitive costs and lack of interest.

A Nomination Committee was appointed: Paula Decker Haynes, Rane Sessions, Carol Gammon, and Mary Lou Hall. The committee will recruit officers for the coming year.

**Adjournment:** The meeting was adjourned at 8:09 p.m.
