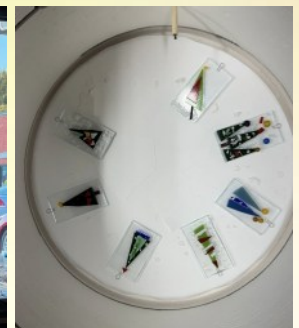
Artist of Month Theme: Open

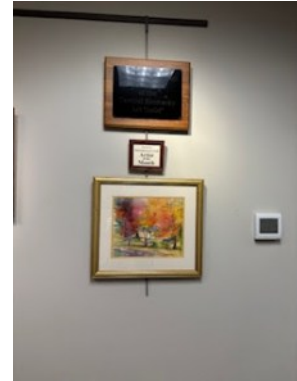
